

April 2021 Meeting Highlights

- **THAT the minutes of the March 17, 2021 regular meeting of council be approved as read.**
- **THAT the RM ratify that the administrator sent out a request for fuel tenders to the Wadena Co-op and Brendonn Holdings stating that the tenders were to be received by 4:00 p.m. April 13, 2021.**
- **THAT discussion on large culverts for the Division 6 Bridge be tabled until May Meeting of Council.**
- **THAT the March Receipts and Payments Statement and Bank Reconciliations be accepted as presented, attached and form part of the minutes.**
- **THAT the municipality accept the lowest diesel tender of 1.08 cents per litre submitted by Wadena Co-op Ltd;
AND THAT we accept the lowest gas tender of 1.105 per litre submitted by the Wadena Co-op Ltd.**
- **THAT the RM ratifies the enactment of a fire ban effective April 8, 2021;**

AND THAT the fire ban be lifted effective April 14, 2021.
