

January Meeting Highlights

- THAT the minutes of the December 11,2019 regular meeting of council be approved as read.
- WHEREAS the municipality has recognized an increase with wild boars within the province;

“WHEREAS Wild Boars are becoming more abundant in many areas of the province which pose a threat to the environment, farm operations and to other livestock; AND

WHEREAS the population of wild boars are growing exponentially due to their adaptability to different habitat, their short gestation period and large litter counts; AND

WHEREAS the current Feral Wild Boar Program run through Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation focuses only on either costly specialized hunting and trapping teams to eradicate their population in certain areas or provide compensation for any crop or livestock damage caused by the pest

BE IT RESOLVED THAT SARM lobby the province to establish a bounty program similar to that of the Beaver Control program to act as an incentive for individuals to assist with controlling the feral wild boar population; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT SARM administer this program with rural municipalities.”

- THAT the administrator contacts a representative from Tick Awareness Canada to be a guest speaker at our Annual Meeting on April 6th, 2020 in addition to Dwight Odelein and Angela Jones.

- THAT the municipality set an advance poll for the Friday preceding election day and that the poll be held at the municipal office.
- THAT the Annual Hendon Drinking Water Quality and Compliance Report be accepted as presented and filed.
- That the monthly Hendon well report be accepted as presented and filed.
- THAT the municipality renew its 2020 membership for the Hudson Bay Route Association.
- THAT the municipality renew its 2020 membership for the North East Area Transportation Planning Committee.
