

May 2021 Meeting Highlights

- THAT the minutes of the April 14, 2021 regular meeting of council be approved as read.
- THAT the RM order (3) 2400mm culverts for the bridge replacement in Division 6 from Prairie Steel.
- THAT the administrator advise Water Security agency of the revised size of (3) 2400mm x 14m culverts for the AHPP.
- THAT the RM order 6 Bridgestone 20.5 x 25 grader tires for the Unit #1 Grader from TNT Tire in Wadena.
- THAT the April Receipts and Payments Statement and Bank Reconciliations be accepted as presented, attached and form part of the minutes.
- THAT discussion on council indemnities be tabled until the public hearing on June 9, 2021.
- THAT the council approved numerous Public Work projects and culverts replacements for the year of 2021.
- THAT the following Division 3 approach work & public work projects be approved for the following location:
 - SE-17-35-15-W2
 - NW-26-35-15-W2

- THAT council approve the gravel maps submitted by the Public Works Foreman for 2021 Gravelling totaling 13575 yards.
- THAT the administrator orders the following culverts from Prairie Steel:
 - (4) 1400mm x 19m
 - (2) 1000mm x 19m
 - (15) 500mm x 14m

- THAT the administrator drafts a new minimum tax bylaw amending the minimum commercial tax rate to \$1100/year for commercial land and buildings combined.
- THAT the operating, capital and cash budget be adopted;
AND THAT a copy of the budget be attached and form part of the minutes.
- THAT the municipality adopt a mill rate of 9.25 mills for 2021.
- THAT the bylaw 01/21 being a bylaw to provide for the application of mill rate factors throughout the

municipality be read a third and final time and adopted.

- THAT the RM continue its participation in the Beaver CAP program administered through SARM 2021 – 2022 year.
- THAT the municipality acknowledge the confirmed education property tax mill rates to be levied with respect to every school division and property class for the 2021 taxation year are as follows:
 - Agriculture 1.36mills
 - Residential 4.46mills
 - Commercial/Industrial 6.75mills
 - Resource (oil and gas, mines and pipelines) 9.79 mills
