

October Meeting Highlights

- **THAT** the minutes of the September 4, 2020 regular meeting of council be approved as read.
- **WHEREAS** a clay source has been located under a SaskPower utility line in the SW-15-36-13-W2;
AND WHEREAS the utility line is obstructing a main clay source for any upgrades to the adjacent road;
BE IT RESLOVED THAT the administrator completes any necessary approval and application forms to have the line relocated to the south of the road at an estimated cost of \$10,470.24 as per SaskPower's quote.
- **THAT** the RM acknowledge the revised lease agreement and the revised 2021 to 2026 Gravel Purchase Agreement with Bruce & Elaine Ewen.
- **THAT** the municipality acknowledge the resignation of the Councillor for Division 6, Dwight Odelein, dated September 29,2020 to take effect at the first meeting of the council following the general election.
- **THAT** the municipality schedule a municipal by-election for the Division 6 Councillor to be held on December 23, 2020, with Nomination Day being scheduled for November 18,2020.
- **THAT** a letter of support be provided to Dr. Jim Dosman for his project on mental health and sleep with the Canadian Centre for Health & Safety in Agriculture.
- **THAT** the confirmed 2020 Hail Roll by SMHI by acknowledge.
- **THAT** we acknowledge the Safe Restart Program Funds received for \$21,953.00.

- **THAT the administrator writes a letter of support to NEATPC and the RM of Lakeside for the reconstruction of the 640 grids.**
- **THAT the Hendon Well Report be accepted as presented and filed.**
- **THAT Public Works commences a shock chlorination and regular test on the Chorney Well for November.**
