- THAT the RM accepts Grader Demo agreement with SMS Equipment Sales Ltd.
- THAT the administrator registers any available staff in the Red Cross CPR First Aid Course to be held October 22 & 23 in Kuroki, SK.
- THAT Carrie Turnbull be registered to attend the RMAA Division 4 Meeting in Kelvington on October 24,2019.
- THAT the Hendon Well monthly report be accepted as presented and filed.
- THAT the municipality donate \$100 to the Health Action Group.
- WHEREAS Weneeda Park Lodge is fundraising to install a new commercial generator for the building that will allow for proper safety measures and capabilities during a power
